

The regular meeting of the Huntingdon County Commissioners was held on the above date and time in the Commissioner's Meeting Room with the following present: Commissioners Sather, Walls and Thomas; Solicitor, Larry Newton; Chief Clerk, Heather Fellman; Sheriff, Jeff Leonard and Daily News Reporter, Joe Thompson.

The meeting was called to order at 9:30 a.m. by Commissioner Sather. Prayer was led by Commissioner Sather and the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag was led by Commissioner Walls.

It was moved by Commissioner Walls, seconded by Commissioner Thomas and carried (Sather, yes; Walls, yes; Thomas, yes) to table approval of the minutes of the previous meeting.

It was moved by Commissioner Thomas, seconded by Commissioner Walls and carried (Walls, yes; Thomas, yes; Sather, yes) to approve payment of bills.

Joe Thompson commented that he has heard many favorable comments about the support that the Commissioners give to veterans in our community.

Sheriff Leonard requested consideration of approval for a four year renewal of the Raystown Lake Law Enforcement Services contract. It was moved by Commissioner Walls, seconded by Commissioner Thomas and carried (Walls, yes; Thomas, yes; Sather, yes).

Heather Fellman, Chief Clerk, requested consideration of approval to hire Travis Baker for the position of full-time Custodian effective 11/13/23. It was moved by Commissioner Thomas, seconded by Commissioner Walls and carried (Thomas, yes; Sather, yes; Walls, yes).

There were no Matters for Action.

There being no further business, it was moved by Commissioner Walls to adjourn the meeting at 9:44 a.m.
