

## **Intergovernmental Agreement**

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INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT

This Agreement by and among the County of Bedford, the County of Fulton and the County of Huntingdon, dated the 30<sup>th</sup> day of April, 2019 is set forth as follows:

1. The parties hereto are parties to an Agreement known as the South Central Solid Waste Agency Agreement.
2. The parties to the Agreement are responsible to develop and implement a Solid Waste Management Plan and practice.
3. The parties are seeking to hire an Engineer/Consultant to assist in developing a Solid Waste Management Plan for the three (3) counties to operate and manage collectively.
4. The parties have awarded an Engineer/Consultant contract to Barton & Loguidice, D. P. C., of Liverpool, New York.
5. The parties to this Agreement acknowledge that the County of Huntingdon will pay the upfront fees and expenses of the Consultant. The South Central Solid Waste Agency joint account will reimburse the County of Huntingdon their up-front cost. Any grant monies received for the purposes of the plan development will reimburse the South Central Solid Waste Agency joint account upon receipt. Each county is responsible for their share of the in-kind match and any other associated costs with developing and adopting the plan.

WHEREFORE, the parties hereto hereby enter into this Agreement intending to be legally bound hereby.

The July 1, 2024 meeting of the Birmingham Borough Council was called to order at 7:00 pm by Council President R. Terry Zeek, with Council Members D. Lee Pryor, Charles Kimberling, George Settle and S. David Pryor in attendance as well as Secretary/Treasurer Brenneman and Code Enforcement/Sewage Enforcement Officer, Dave Piper.

Guest present: Santina Ashby

**Public Comments**

None

Pursuant to a motion by Council Member Charles Kimberling, seconded by Council Member David Pryor and passed unanimously with the vote of all others, the minutes of the June 3, 2024 Borough Council Meeting were approved as presented.

Secretary/Treasurer Brenneman provided Council with the following account balances as of June 30, 2024:

Secretary/Treasurer Brenneman also reported that the Borough's Certificate of Deposit matured on June 22 and the new terms via automatic renewal are 6 months at .9963%. A motion was then made by Council Member Charles Kimberling, seconded by Council Member Lee Pryor and passed unanimously with the vote of all others to accept the Treasurer's report, pay all bills and to cash in the certificate of deposit and reinvest once a better interest rate is obtained.

**Old Business**

Code Enforcement/Sewage Enforcement Officer David Piper is still awaiting receipt of a 1932-1933 state survey from the Pennsylvania Game Commission to move the research on Borough properties forward.

Council Member David Pryor provided an update from the Mitigation Plan Meeting for Huntingdon County held at the Smithfield Fire Company on June 24 at 6:00 pm. He noted that if Birmingham Borough wishes to be eligible for emergency funds provided by the federal government, it would be in the Borough's best interest to participate in the County's Mitigation Plan. Funds can be distributed to non-participants, but funding is not as likely. When the federal government deems a federal emergency and distributes funds, the monies are able to be used for a variety of reasons. Council Member Pryor noted he was willing to do the "leg work" and to submit all paperwork and/or virtual paperwork for Birmingham's participation. A motion was then made by Council Member George Settle, seconded by Council Member Lee Pryor and passed unanimously with the vote of all others for Birmingham to participate as a member of the Mitigation Plan and for Council Member David Pryor to take the lead in the submission of all forms to acquire such status.

Council Member D. Lee Pryor provided an update on a telephone call received by the Borough last month. A film crew from Birmingham England is working on a documentary on "Birmingham" that is expected to be completed in 2025. The film crew visited Birmingham, Pennsylvania and talked with several residents including Lee Pryor, Charles and Betty Kimberling and Geoffrey Grier. The film crew provided a proclamation declaring Birmingham, Pennsylvania an official sister city. A plaque was also presented to Council Member Pryor. Although the documentary will only be available in the United Kingdom a link will be provided so that individuals in the United States will be able to view it.

Council Member Lee Pryor noted that Jack Ashcroft is continuing to mow for the Borough.

Council President Zeek reported he has continued to follow up with several individuals in the quest to obtain a new sewage enforcement officer but been unsuccessful. He will continue to make contacts.

Council President Zeek reported that there have been no further updates about the Street Light. If he does not hear soon, he will reach out once again. It is assumed that Lumineer is still awaiting the work order and they will have it installed soon.

### **New Business**

Pursuant to a motion by Council Member Charles Kimberling, seconded by Council Member George Settle and passed unanimously with the vote of all others, Santana Ashby was appointed as Secretary/Treasurer effective August 1, 2024.

Council President Zeek talked with Tyrone's postmaster about the possibility of the Borough renting a post office box so that future mail can be centralized. Pursuant to a motion by Council Member Charles Kimberling, seconded by Council Member Lee Pryor and passed unanimously with the vote of all others, Council approved obtaining a post office box at a cost of \$41 every six months.

The condition of Centre Alley was briefly discussed with a walk over to immediately follow after the meeting. It was noted there is a pipe that does not permit water flow to exit directly into an outlet and wash out is occurring.

Information on the updated Regional Municipal Solid Waste Management Plan (SWMP), previously shared with Council Members via email, was briefly discussed. A motion was then made by Council Member George Settle, seconded by Council Member Lee Pryor and passed unanimously with the vote of all others to ratify the County's SWMP.

Council President Terry Zeek then took a moment to thank Secretary/Treasurer Brenneman for her years of service to the Borough, followed by the thanks of many other Council Members.

There being no additional business before Council, the meeting was adjourned at 7:45 pm with a motion being made by Council Member David Pryor, seconded by Council Member George Settle and passed unanimously with the vote of all others.





The July 2, 2024 meeting of the Board of Supervisors of Warriors Mark Township was called to order at approximately 6:30 pm, with Chairman Neff, Supervisors Hockenberry and Liese, Solicitor Stants, Engineer Haefner, Code Enforcement Officer, Dave Piper and Secretary/Treasurer Brenneman all being present. Emergency Management Coordinator, Kyle Seeger was absent.

**Public Comment:**

- None

**Zoning Officer's Report:**

- Six Zoning Permits were issued in June
  - one for a single family dwelling
  - one for solar panels
  - one for pergola with solar panels
  - one for a car port
  - one for a replacement storage shed
  - one for a pavilion
- Attended various meetings over the past month

**SEO Report:**

- One Septic Permit was issued, as well as soil testing performed
- Dipped five tanks
- Provided an inspection report for Mary Shingler's residence from last year
- Has a meeting scheduled with Gillilands
- Pumping receipt received for yellow apartment building but no receipts provided for the other two buildings by NLS, owners of apartment buildings down town
- Suggested the Township consider waiting to perform a perc test for new building site until further information is available from an architect regarding building size, occupancy, etc. The soil appears to be very good. A pressurized system would be recommended.

**Fire Company Report:**

- June 9 a wing event was held and 113 wings, 22 doz perogies, and 37 boneless wings were served

**Warriors Mark General Authority:**

- Meter readings were just done
- Still trying to find a concrete contractor

**Secretaries Reports:**

- Pursuant to a motion made by Supervisor Hockenberry, seconded by Supervisor Liese and approved unanimously with the vote of Chairman Neff, the minutes from the Board of Supervisors Meeting held June 4, 2024 were approved.
- Pursuant to a motion made by Supervisor Liese, seconded by Supervisor Hockenberry and approved unanimously with the vote of Chairman Neff, the expenditures presented on July 2, 2024, in the amount of \$18,636.40 were approved. Receipts for June totaled \$36,592.41.
- Secretary Reese reported that 216 reminder postcards were mailed on June 27<sup>th</sup> for 2024 septic pumping.
- Secretary Reese also reported that there are 15 remaining tax parcels non-compliant for 2023.

**Board Comments:**

- Pursuant to a motion made by Supervisor Hockenberry, seconded by Supervisor Liese and approved unanimously with the vote of Chairman Neff, Warriors Mark Township approved a Fireworks Permit for July 27 at the Gillbrook Farm.
- Pursuant to a motion made by Supervisor Liese, seconded by Supervisor Hockenberry and approved unanimously with the vote of Chairman Neff, Warriors Mark Township accepted the resignation of Secretary/Treasurer Julie Brenneman effective July 31, 2024
- Pursuant to a motion made by Supervisor Liese, seconded by Supervisor Hockenberry and approved unanimously with the vote of Chairman Neff, Warriors Mark Township appointed Sonja Malvoisin Secretary/Treasurer effective August 1, 2024.
- IworQ Software was discussed. This is a newly developed septic tracking software. Purchase will be tabled until a new Sewage Enforcement Officer is hired.
- The search for a replacement sewage enforcement officer continues. Chairman Neff has reached out to Kasey Snell for further discussions.
- Two Architectural Firms were considered for the design of a new Township Building. The Firms were McKissick Kasun Architects from Hollidaysburg and HAD Architecture and Design from Boalsburg. After a brief discussion, a motion was made by Supervisor Hockenberry, seconded by Supervisor Liese and approved unanimously with the vote of Chairman Neff, to hire HAD Architecture and Design as the Township's Architect for the design of a new Township Building
- Supervisor Liese suggested if any ARP monies remain the Board consider the installation of a well at the Knarr shed property
- Supervisor Liese also suggested the Board consider the installation of a water line to the new pavilion at the Upper Park.

- Ratification of the Huntingdon County Regional Municipal Solid Waste Management Plan (SWMP) was discussed with a motion was made by Supervisor Liese, seconded by Supervisor Hockenberry and approved unanimously with the vote of Chairman Neff, to approve.
- Clean Up/Clean Out Days were quite successful. This year 5 dumpsters were filled with community waste.
- Keller Engineers is “tweaking” the Township’s Act 537 Plan for submission to the Department of Environmental Protection in the near future.
- Chairman Neff asked the Board to consider drafting correspondence to Representative Gregory and Senator Ward in opposition to any action regarding accessing a per capita fee to municipalities for PA State Police coverage
- Seal coating is scheduled for July 8 on Firehouse Road, the end of Meadow Wood Lane and the end of Reese Road
- Supervisor Neff reported on consideration of the township upgrading Eyer Station from a gravel roadway surface to a sealcoat road, specifically a surface treated road. Along with that when the large wooded parcel at the end of Eyer Station Road was owned by the Wolf Family there was an agreement to utilize an area owned by the Wolf’s to be used as a turnaround; ie Cul-de-sac. Neff contacted the current towner, Rob Replogle regarding possible upgrading of Eyer Station but to do so the township would need a turn around area where the road meets his property. Mr. Replogle is willing to provide the township with an easement for that purpose and is willing to help with installation. Neff hopes that this can be accomplished in time for surveying for Cul-de-sac, legal agreement, roadway preparation in time for 2025 Surface Treatment bidding.

**Public Comment:**

- Bill Anderson, President of the Little Juniata River Association addressed the Board of Supervisors hoping to determine ownership of property just south of Birmingham/Grier School area, as the property is often found vandalized and trashed. State Police have advised that the owner must bring forth charges rather than the LJRA. Tax parcel 52-15-14 was the identified as the property in question, which does not seem to show on any maps. It was thought to be Game Commission property, however this has not been confirmed. Mr. Anderson was advised to reach out to Judy Ward’s office for assistance in identifying the rightful owner.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:15 p.m. with the motion being made by Supervisor Hockenberry, seconded by Supervisor Liese and passed unanimously with the vote of Chairman Neff.

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

September 4, 2024

In Attendance: Ronna McCabe, Roy McCabe, Rick Rourke, Leroy Wright, Billee McCavitt, Tom Henderson, Supervisor Love, Supervisor Kirby Lockard, Supervisor Anthony Lockard, Secretary Hall

Auditor Donna McCabe stated that all three Township Auditors plan to attend the Huntingdon County Township Officials Association Convention, being held next Thursday.

EMC Roy McCabe said that Huntingdon County continues to be in severe drought conditions.

Resident Billee McCavitt asked when Trick or Treat would be held in Wood Township. The Supervisors set Thursday, October 31<sup>st</sup> from 6-8 PM as Trick or Treat night.

Resident Leroy Wright stated that according to Wood Township Ordinance 95-1, regarding non-operating vehicles, property owners are only allowed to have one non-registered vehicle on their property. He is concerned about the amount of non-operating/registered vehicles in the Township. He is also concerned about the tires lying about properties in the Township. The Supervisors stated that Wood Township does not have an ordinance addressing the issue and that once per year tires are accepted at Bulky Waste Day and disposed of at the cost of the Township. Mr. Wright also said that the new paving looks good on Lincoln Street.

One application was received from Larry Cross to serve on the WBTW JMA Board of Directors. He will fill an open position created by a board member resigning last month. The position will last until the end of 2024. Supervisor Love made a motion to appoint Mr. Cross to the position with a second by Supervisor Anthony Lockard.
